## ABOUT THE PROGRAMME:

The aim of the Young Leaders Development Programme (YLDP) is to develop young leaders through enhancing their leadership skills and strengthening their knowledge of climate change so that they feel equipped to take action.

We believe that in order to help lead the way to a successful, low carbon future, there are three spheres of influence that must be addressed: personal, professional and political. Therefore, this year's programme will be split into these three spheres.



### PERSONAL

How can we change our own lives, and the lives, behaviours and decisions of those around us to better tackle climate change?



### PROFESSIONAL

How can we influence the places we work, the businesses we buy goods and services from, and the businesses we have no connection with?



### POLITICAL

How do we effectively influence politicians and politics from the local level up to the international stage?
